

**North Carolina Presbyterian Pilgrimage  
Leadership Council Meeting  
Community in Christ Presbyterian Church, Greensboro  
6:30 PM, December 7, 2000**

Present were: Joe Burke, Sally Royster, Chip Leonard, Cindi Maynard, Lenwood Collins, Bill Wardlaw, Donna Earp, Wilson Davis, Robin Britt, Jr., Linda Mason and Jim Mason.

Jim Mason opened the meeting with a devotional reading and prayer. Prayer requests were heard for: Judy Fore & her family, Dawn White, Bill Wardlaw's daughter Nancy, Lenwood's son Adam, and Donna Braswell.

The minutes of the October 26<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved as distributed.

The Treasurer's report was received and approved.

Joe Burke and Sally Royster gave reports on their teams' progress toward weekends #41 and #42. Both teams are essentially complete, and the lists of team members were circulated. Sally will hold her first team meeting on January 6<sup>th</sup>. The Ultreya will be March 3<sup>rd</sup> at Centenary UMC. Joe pointed out that a new musician, who was a guest on #40, was recruited to serve on #42, expanding the short list of music chas in the East.

Operations: Lenwood Collins reported that the Pilgrimage supplies should be moved from the current storage area since Lew is leaving the Council. He moved that a commercial storage area be rented for this purpose at a cost of approximately \$75/mo. The motion passed.

Newsletter: Linda reported that only about 100 replies had come in responding to the request to be notified if one wished to remain on the mailing list. Wilson suggested that we not pruned the list at this time since it is our best contact mechanism for the Fourth Day community. Maintaining this contact is one of the “costs of doing business.” Robin Britt, Jr. and Donna Earp will pursue obtaining bulk mail permits with “non-profit” status. One is needed for the Fayetteville bulk mail center and one for Greensboro.

Reunion: Cindi presented a form that she requested be distributed to the Fourth Day to help update the Reunion Group List. It is currently quite out of date. She is also considering other avenues through the Ultreyas to get current information.

Fourth Day: As a follow-up to the previous meeting, Linda reported that there is an easy mechanism to produce an alphabetical listing of Pilgrims who attended weekends after the current Directory was published. It can be updated after each weekend or whatever interval is desired.

Registrar: No Report

Palanca: Bryan and Michelle sent a request from Kairos for support of a new trailer that has been purchased to facilitate production of 8 weekends annually in NC. The cost was about \$9,000 and all but about \$1,500 of it has already been subscribed. A motion was made to send \$750 at this time, and see if more is needed. The motion passed.
