History of Presbyterian Pilgrimage

Presbyterian Pilgrimage is an outgrowth of a movement, which originated as the Roman Catholic Cursillo in Spain in 1948 and moved to America in the late 50's. In fact the Presbyterian weekends in North Carolina were called Cursillos until 1997. The first Cursillos within the US (Roman Catholic) were held in Miami, Florida in 1971. In addition to the Roman Catholic and Presbyterian movements, there

are similar expressions in the Methodist, Reformed Episcopal, Lutheran, and other Christian



churches. Today, more than 2 million Christians in 50 nations have attended a Cursillo, Pilgrimage, or similar weekend.

What Palanca really means...

Palanca is a Spanish word that means "lever." Just as a lever enables a person to move something which is beyond normal strength, palanca empowers the accomplishment of things which would not be possible without the Grace of God. Palanca surprises us into the grace of God. It takes the form of prayers, tokens of love and cards.

The Serenade is a most powerful form of Palanca. Reunion groups bring your Palanca early so the chas can organize their week-end. Sponsors and friends, don't forget these special items for your guests.

Directions to YMCA Camp Harrison

(note that the stone sign along the road says "Herring Ridge" in larger letters with "Camp Harrison" in much smaller letters below that.)

From Charlotte:(approx. 1 ½ hours)

Take 77 North to 421 North.
Merge onto 16/18 toward Lenoir/Taylorsville onto NC18 and travel about 5 miles.
Turn right onto NC18 and travel about 5 miles.
Look for Herring Ridge/Camp Harrison on the left.

From Greensboro: (approx. 1 ½ hours)

Take 40 West to 421 North (Exit 286-A)
Turn onto NC 16/18 South toward Lenoir.
Turn Right Taylorsville.
Drive 3 miles and turn Right onto NC18 and travel about 8.2 miles.
Look for Herring Ridge/Camp Harrison on the left.

From Charlotte:

77N to Exit 23 Turn right into Gilead Road. Counting the traffic light at the top of the ramp, go to the third light and turn right on Old Statesville Road (where the Police Station and Town Hall are). The church is one block down on the left..

From Greensboro:

I-40 to Exit 152A and I-77 South On I-77 South, take Exit 23 At top of ramp, turn left onto Gilead Road. Cross over the bridge , then go 3 lights and turn right at the third one onto Old Statesville Road. (where the police Station & Town Hall are). The church is one block down on the left..

“Blessed are those whose strength is in You, who have set their hearts on pilgrimage.” (Psalm 84:5)

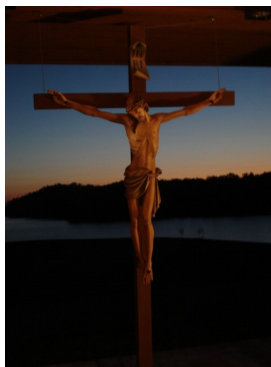
