Packing Up Reminders

1. Pack up whatever is not needed for Closura from Chapel after morning service.
2. After lunch, pack up kitchen.
3. After outside has removed guest luggage from cabins, pick up toiletries and remove trash. Please check for trash in team cabins.
4. After Palanca Bags are given to guests, pack up Palanca.
5. After Rollo's are finished, entire team will help break down Rollo Room.
6. After guests have card dedication, Knees Palanca can be packed up.
7. After Closura, remainder of Chapel can be packed up and chairs will be put in closet.
8. Then pack up remainder of Rollo Room items

Directions to YMCA Camp Harrison

From Charlotte:(approx. 1 ½ hours)
 Take 77 North to 421 North.
 Merge onto 16/18 toward Lenoir/Taylorsville onto
 NC18 and travel about 5 miles.
 Turn right onto NC18 and travel about 5 miles.
 Look for Herring Ridge/Camp Harrison on the left.

From Greensboro: (approx. 1 ½ hours)
 Take 40 West to 421 North (Exit 286-A)
 Turn onto NC 16/18 South toward Lenoir.
 Turn Right Taylorsville.
 Drive 3 miles and turn Right onto NC18 and travel about 8.2 miles.
 Look for Herring Ridge/Camp Harrison on the left.
