**FROM POINTS NORTH:**

I-95 S to Hwy 87 (Exit 46)  
Take Hwy 87 S towards Elizabethtown for 14 miles  
Go approx 1 mile past the Dupont Plant entrance  
Turn right onto Bladen Union Church Road  
(The next paved right)  
Camp Dixie will be on your left.

**FROM POINTS SOUTH:**

I-95 N to Hwy 20 E (St Pauls Exit)  
Continue through St. Pauls, past the landfill and  
Rocco Farms Plant  
Cross a little bridge at Gallberry Swamp and then  
cross the county line  
Take the next left onto Pages Lake Road  
Continue for approx 2 miles  
Camp Dixie will be on the right.
