Bear right on **US-70** and go 5 miles

Turn rt on **NC-1553, Shotwell Rd** .06 mile
Bear right on **Amelia Church Rd** 2.0 miles

From Fayetteville, Lumberton

Take I-95 to I-40 (West)
Continue on **I-40** to **exit 312**
Exit **I-40** via ramp at sign reading "Exit **312 NC-42** to **Clayton / Fuquay-Varina**"
Turn right on **NC-42 W** 4.2 miles
Turn left onto **Amelia Church Rd, NC-1552**. Church is just ahead on your left.

CAMP DIXIE

FROM POINT NORTH:

I-95 S to Hwy 87 (Exit 46)
Take Hwy 87 S towards Elizabethtown for 14 miles
Go approx 1 mile past the DuPont Plant entrance
Turn right onto Bladen Union Church Road
(the next paved right)
Camp Dixie will be on your left.

FROM POINTS SOUTH:

I-95 N to Hwy 20 E (St Pauls Exit)
Continue through St. Pauls, past the landfill and
Rocco Farms Plant
Cross a little bridge at Gallberry Swamp and then
cross the county line
Take the next left onto Pages Lake Road
Continue for approx 2 miles
Camp Dixie will be on the right.
