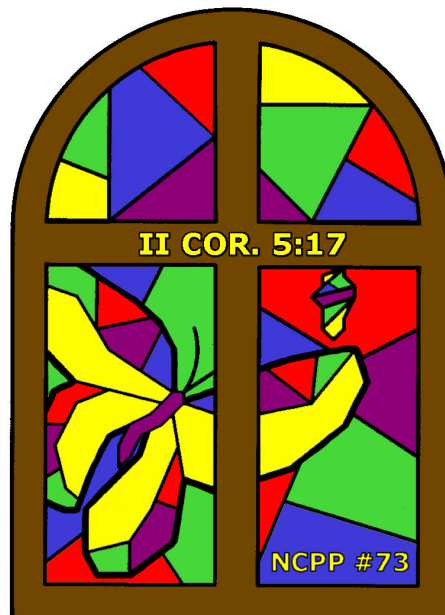

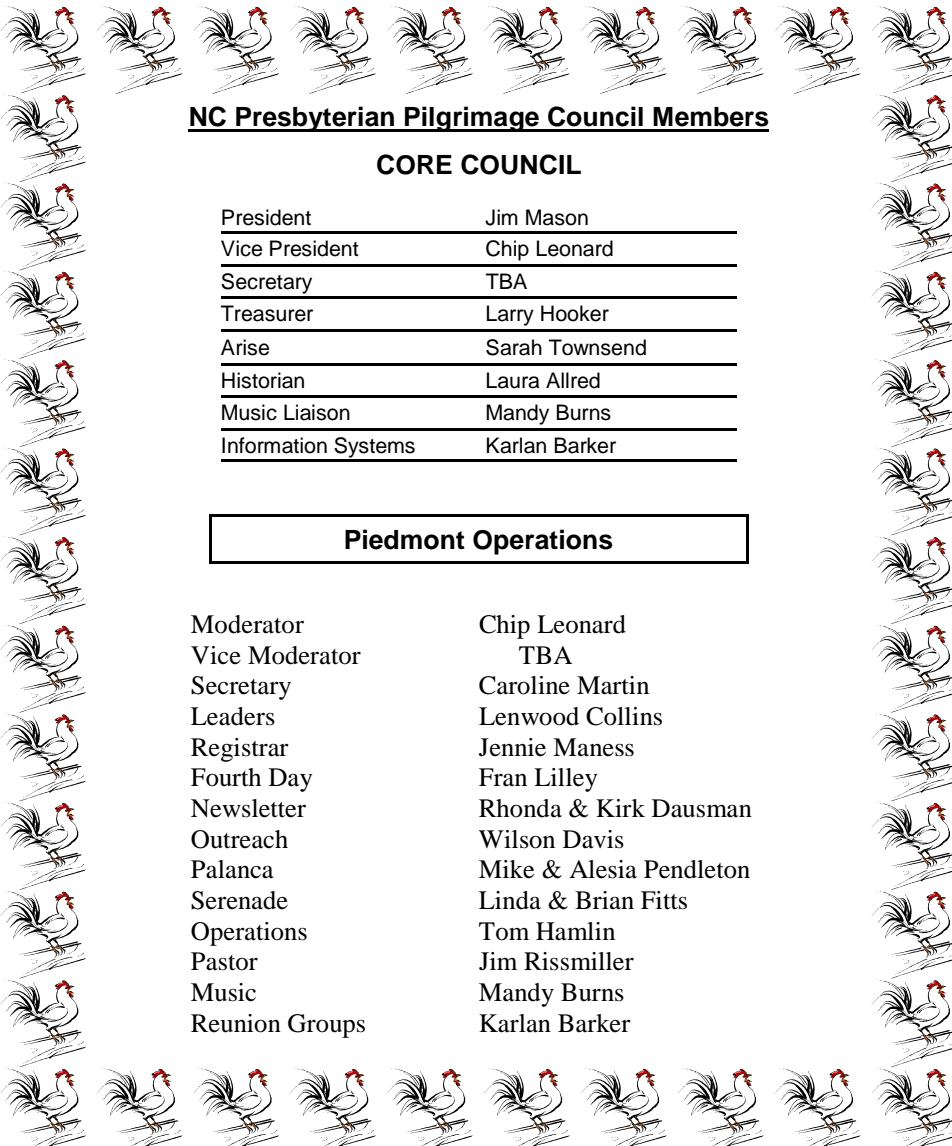

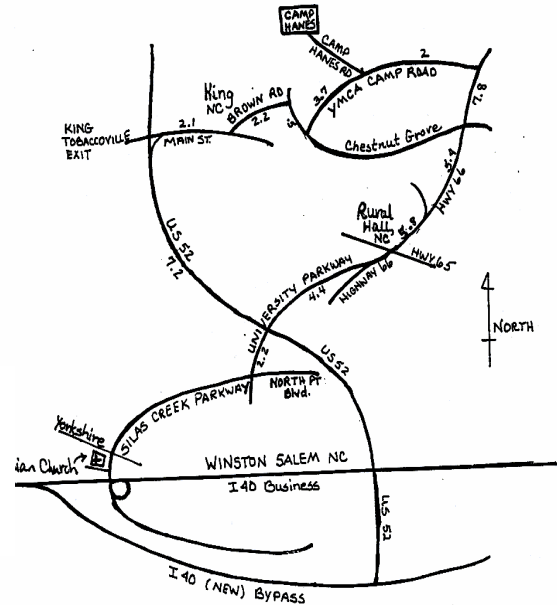
THE CHURCH'S LOWER PARKING LOT IS ON YOUR RIGHT. WE WILL MEET IN THE FELLOWSHIP HALL (THE BUILDING WITH THE BEAUTIFUL STAINED-GLASS CROSS) LOOK FOR THE ROOSTER!

**DIRECTIONS FROM GREENSBORO:** TAKE I-40 W TOWARDS WINSTON-SALEM. WHERE "NEW 40" AND "OLD (BUSINESS) 40" INTERSECT, GO LEFT ONTO "NEW 40." TAKE THE HANES MALL BLVD. EXIT. AT THE END OF THE EXIT RAMP, TURN RIGHT. GO UNTIL HANES MALL BLVD. DEAD-ENDS. FORSYTH HOSPITAL WILL BE AHEAD. TURN LEFT ONTO SILAS CREEK PARKWAY, NORTH (NC-67W). DRIVE UNTIL YOU SEE A SOCCER FIELD (SHOFFNER PARK) ON YOUR RIGHT (LESS THAN 2 MILES). PARKWAY CHURCH WILL BE ON THE LEFT. IMMEDIATELY ACROSS FROM THE SOCCER FIELD IS A LEFT TURN LANE. TURN LEFT ONTO KIRKLEES ROAD.

**DIRECTIONS FROM CHARLOTTE:** TAKE I-77 NORTH. TAKE THE I-40 EAST EXIT (# 51A) TOWARDS WINSTON-SALEM AT THE SPLIT OF BUSINESS 40 AND INTERSTATE 40, GET INTO THE LEFT LANE AND TAKE EXIT 188 (BUSINESS 40E / 421 S./ DOWNTOWN W-S). TAKE EXIT 2B ( SILAS CREEK PARKWAY, NORTH / NC 67 W ). DRIVE ABOUT 1.5 MILES UNTIL YOU SEE A SOCCER FIELD (SHOFFNER PARK) ON YOUR RIGHT. PARKWAY CHURCH WILL BE ON THE LEFT. IMMEDIATELY ACROSS FROM THE SOCCER FIELD IS A LEFT TURN LANE. TURN LEFT ONTO KIRKLEES ROAD.

**FROM CITIES WEST OF WINSTON-SALEM :**TAKE US-52 SOUTH. TAKE EXIT #115 (UNIVERSITY PARKWAY). KEEP RIGHT AT THE FORK TO GO ONTO UNIVERSITY PKWY. GO APPROXIMATELY 2 MILES AND TURN RIGHT ON NORTH POINT BLVD. NORTH POINT BLVD. BECOMES SILAS CREEK PARKWAY. GO ABOUT 3.5 MILES. AT THE INTERSECTION OF SILAS CREEK AND YORKSHIRE ROAD, YOU WILL SEE PARKWAY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH ON YOUR RIGHT. GO STRAIGHT, PAST THE CHURCH. TURN RIGHT ON KIRKLEES ROAD.

**DIRECTIONS TO CAMP HANES:**  
TAKE 52-N. TAKE EXIT #123 (KING/TOBACCOVILLE). AT TOP OF RAMP, GO RIGHT. GO 2.1 MILES TO BROWN ROAD. TURN LEFT ONTO BROWN ROAD. GO 2.2 MILES, UNTIL IT ENDS. TURN RIGHT ON CHESTNUT GROVE ROAD. GO .6 MILES AND TURN
