As we look forward to this year, we celebrate that we will be experiencing three more Pilgrimage weekends here in the Piedmont. Can you believe 2008 will bring the total NC Presbyterian Pilgrimage/Cursillo weekends to eighty-seven?

I urge each of you to support the weekends and those guests in attendance. There are several ways for you to do this:

Seriously consider and pray about sponsoring someone for a weekend. Take time to read over the sponsor's form. Remember what you experienced on your weekend.

Sign up to commit to pray during any of the seventy-two time slots on the prayer banner. Your prayer support for the guests and team throughout the weekend is essential. Early morning and late night times are real palanca. Remember the meaning of the word palanca, plank or lever, a device by which we are able to move an object beyond our

abilities. Palanca includes letters of encouragement and prayer support, small gifts tied to commitments of prayer from individuals or reunion groups, letters from friends and family to guests, and a time of service and assistance as members of the Fourth Day Community. Serenade is a great way to participate in showing the love and light of Christ. Remember the "Choir of Angels" that surrounded you on your weekend? While the closing is often thought of as the end of the weekend, it is in fact the new Pilgrims' beginning of a new life in Christ. Your encouragement, enthusiasm, and joy at the closing will act as a lever, palanca, for the new Pilgrims as they begin their Fourth Day. The Ultreya, which is held two weeks after the weekend, might be called the Great Reunion because former guests and team members from former weekends renew friendships, share a meal, and conversation together. Serve on a team. It is never too late to experience the pure joy of being Christ's servant on a Pilgrimage Weekend. Team applications are found on the

web site. Read the newsletter. It is full of information, key dates and times, web site addresses, directions, names and places, and things to do. I look forward to seeing you at any and all of these activities. God loves you and so do I.

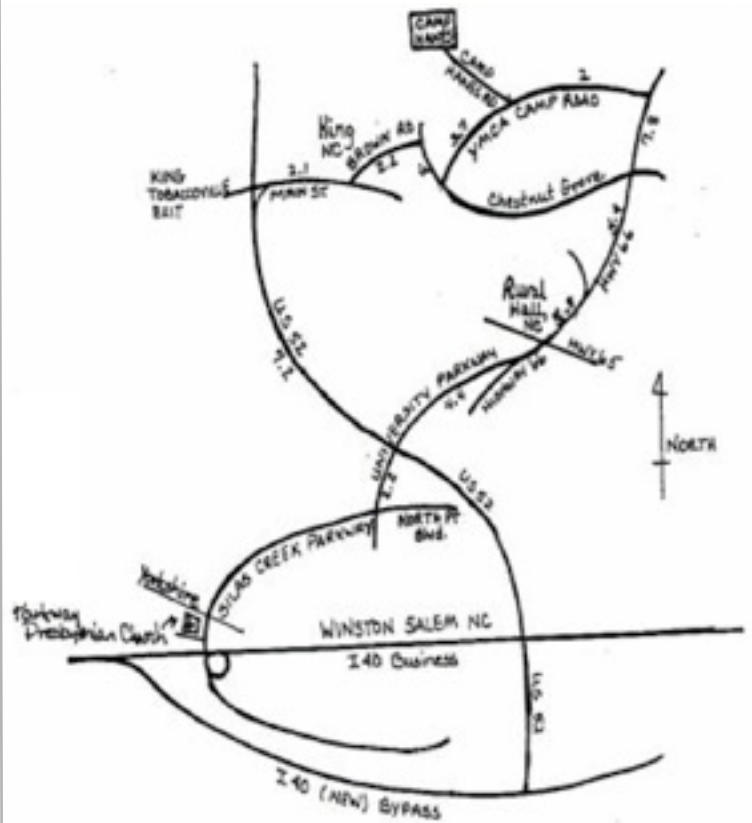
