Letter From The Rector

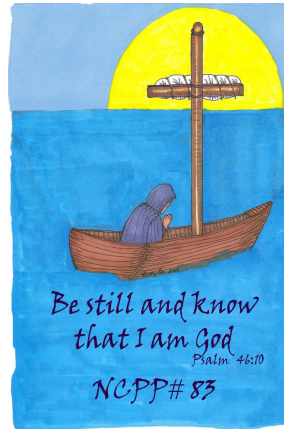
Dear Friends,

Fayetteville**

From points north:

Take I-95 South to Fayetteville/Elizabethtown exit at Hwy 87 Proceed toward Fayetteville onto Hwy 87 (Martin Luther King Expressway) Follow to Hay Street exit. Turn left at stoplight at top of ramp. Highland Presbyterian is one block on your left. Turn left at light after front of church onto Highland Avenue.

From points south

Take I-95 North to Fayetteville/Elizabethtown exit at Hwy 87 Proceed toward Fayetteville onto Hwy 87 (Martin Luther King Expressway) Follow to Hay Street exit. Turn left at stoplight at top of ramp. Highland Presbyterian is one block on your left. Turn left at light after front of church onto Highland Avenue.

CAMP DIXIE

FROM POINTS NORTH:

I-95 S to Hwy 87 (Exit 46)
Take Hwy 87 S towards Elizabethtown for 14 miles
Go approx 1 mile past the DuPont Plant entrance
Turn right onto Bladen Union Church Road
(the next paved right)
Camp Dixie will be on your left.

FROM POINTS SOUTH:

I-95 N to Hwy 20 E (St Pauls Exit)
Continue through St. Pauls, past the landfill and Rocco Farms Plant
Cross a little bridge at Gallberry Swamp and then cross the county line
Take the next left onto Pages Lake Road
Continue for approx 2 miles
Camp Dixie will be on the right.
